The life-threatening accident occurred in Connecticut and he was airlifted to a hospital in New Haven. He broke several major bones and was in the hospital for six weeks before he was able to head home. He has made a terrific comeback and although he may not be the athlete he once was (still, when he is able to play a few minutes, he gives everything he has. He also has been a great leader from the bench."

His dedication paid off as led both the Pilgrim football and basketball teams to the playoffs this year."
